

#### He Taupua

- Purpose: to support iwi, hapū and Māori entities to increase capability to develop their whenua for housing.
- **Funding scope:** business cases for housing developments, project facilitation and coordination, feasibility studies, whānau housing needs analysis.
- Funding limit: up to a max of \$500,000 per project.

#### He Taupae

- Purpose: to support technical planning and development preparation to ensure viability of housing development.
- **Scope:** geotechnical investigations; master planning; infrastructure reports, contamination reports; traffic assessments, resource and building consents.
- Funding limit: up to a max of \$750,000 per project.

### He Kūkū ki te Kāinga

- Purpose: to support the increase of new housing supply
- **Scope:** affordable rentals, affordable homeownership, community housing, transitional housing, onsite infrastructure
- Funding limit: as per Whai Kāinga Whai Oranga Investment Framework
