- Ranfurly St, Moerewa Social Housing
- 35 homes (2, 3 and 4 bedrooms)
- Initially Social Housing rentals with the possibility in the future progressive ownership

FUNDING SUPPORT

- He Taupua Fund
- Final stages of submitting our application for Whai Kainga Whai Ora funding

OUR EXPERIENCE

- Initial funding assistance was instrumental to progress
- Specialist engagement in the early stages vital
- Important to ask HUD questions so you are clear on what you need to do
- Applicants only know what they know beneficial HUD forthcoming with guidance and support
